

WOLVES AT THE DOOR: UNDERSTANDING BULLIES, VICTIMS AND BYSTANDERS

This presentation will help adults who work with youth identify, respond to, and safeguard against bullying. Participants will learn how factors such as behavior patterns, behavioral motivation and youth perceptions influence the actions of both bullies and victims. Participants will learn approaches and strategies to address immediate behavioral issues to halt this conduct and help those who become casualties of these actions.

Participants will become familiar with strategies on how to “Keep the wolves at Bay”. Programs and materials will be introduced that are designed to help adults link, and teach appropriate pro-social skills to the wolf (bully) and the sheep (victim).

This program will assist adults in helping youth develop skills needed to change aggression to positive leadership and terror to triumph.
